TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR HIRE OF MONSOPIAD CULTURAL VILLAGE VENUE

1. Terms & Conditions - PAYMENTS

a) Payments apply if not otherwise discussed and agreed upon.

2. Liability of Monsopiad Cultural Village

a) Monsopiad Cultural Village (MCV) shall act according to the programmed as discussed with the hirer.

3. Decorations Provided by MCV

a) If not otherwise agreed upon with the hirer, MCV shall provide only the following decorations:

i. Bamboo torches to light pathways.

ii. Electrical illuminations of entrance, staircase to the House of Skulls, Souvenir Shop, Tangkob, rice distillery, Kotos di Monsopiad, Riverside Cafe and main hall.

iii. Decoration of the main hall will be leafy branches and palm fronds (jungle theme)

iv. Narrow long tables with batik table cloths and cushions stool seat

b) MCV will provide no other decorations if not otherwise agreed upon.

c) The hirer may decide to use only part of or none of MCV's decorations and bring their own decoration.

d) All changes in decoration and the programmed have to be discussed earlier with the management of MCV pending approval.

4. Food & Drinks

a) MCV shall provide halal food at all time.

b) MCV proposes a menu or a choice of menus for the hirer to choose from or change although prices may vary accordingly.

c) MCV provides rice-wine as a welcome drink and non-alcoholic welcome drinks can be served but only if specifically specified by the hirer.

d) If the hirer caters for their own food, any halal food may be served.

e) If not otherwise agreed upon, a cover charge of 15% of your selling price shall be levied on any bottle of wine, beer or liquor sold to visitors at MCV.

f) The hirer shall purchase all rice-wine (lihing, tapai) and rice-alcohol (talak) from MCV.

5. Entertainment

a) MCV ensemble and troupe shall provide music and the cultural show.

b) If the hirer wishes to entertain guests with other forms of entertainment than the cultural show by the MCV troupe, no reductions for the non-use of the troupe are given.

c) Any change to the programmed and any addition or exclusion of it, the hirer must be on communicating terms with the management of MCV for approval.

d) Only traditional music and activities can be performed in the MCV compound.

6. Damages and Indemnity

a) MCV cannot be held responsible for any loss of any goods or belongings to the hirer, to his sub-contractor, staff or to his guests.

b) The hirer shall be held liable for all damages occurred through non-compliance with the above terms & conditions, or willful and intentional damages, carelessness of his guests or staff (e.g. sub-contractor for cooking and serving), and he or she will have to indemnify MCV fully for the repair of such damages.
